- (a) Applications and nominations are invited on the prescribed form (Form C) for the above awards to reach the Hony. Secretary of the Institute of Chemistry on or before 29th February 2016.
- (b) Nominations of eligible candidates shall be entertained only from higher educational institutions, research institutions and members of the Institute of Chemistry Ceylon.
- (c) Applications or Nomination will be entertained in respect of qualified Chemists engaged in the Profession of Chemical Sciences who are **members of the Institute of Chemistry Ceylon (M.I.Chem.C and not A.I.Chem.C. or L.I.Chem.C.)**.
- (d) Applications and nominations will be entertained only on an individual basis. In the case of joint work, those involved in such work could apply on an individual basis, stating the degree of the individual's contribution.

2. In the case of Kandiah Memorial Awards the work presented for the award should have been carried out within **five years** of the closing date for applications and/or nominations for the award. In the case of those who registered for post graduate degree by course work, the degree should have been awarded when the application/nomination is made.

3. Awards will, however, not be made if the work submitted is not of a suitable standard.

4. These awards will be presented at the Annual Sessions of the Institute of Chemistry, Ceylon. Work previously presented and recognized for any award shall not be taken into account unless further work has been carried out to a significant extent.
5. The recipient of each award shall be invited to deliver the respective Award Lecture on the work submitted, at the Annual Sessions of the Institute.
6. The applications and nominations should be accompanied by the following:-
 - i. Three copies of detailed Curriculum Vitae.
 - ii. Three copies of an outline (not exceeding 2000 words) describing the contribution.
 - iii. Three copies of all relevant material (publications and patents) in support of the application.
 - iv. A certificate from the Head of the Institution or University or Department to certify that the work has been carried out by the applicant/nominee at that institution
 - v. A copy of a recent passport size photograph.
 - vi. Three copies of an abstract (not exceeding 500 words of the proposed award lecture, duly signed by the applicant or nominee). A copy of the abstract shall be made available to the referee.
7. No application/Nomination should be made in respect of any work for more than one award.
8. The medium of communication shall be English.
9. The decision of the Council on all matters pertaining to the awards shall be final.
